We have opened a (fixed-term) Senior Researcher position and a position for a (mixed-term) Postdoctoral Researcher / PhD Student in Space Physics at the University of Turku (UTU), Finland, to join our team developing energetic particle instrumentation for nanosatellites. The persons will work in two satellite projects related to the /Finnish Centre of Excellence in Research of Sustainable Space/ (FORESAIL) — a collaboration between four Finnish partner institutes, funded by the Academy of Finland. Both positions are placed at UTU's Department of Physics and Astronomy, which is a community of more than 100 physicists and astronomers with three professors and more than 30 other research personnel working in space sciences.
