I am writing to let you know about a postdoctoral research position that will be opening at the University of Arizona in the Solar and Heliospheric research group within the Lunar and Planetary Laboratory. We are interested in candidates who will work with me on combining theory with the analysis of in situ solar wind observations as a means of characterizing the plasma processes that occur in the heliosphere and in space and astrophysical plasmas more generally.
